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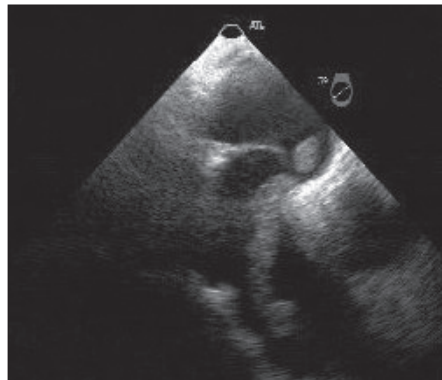
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Standard journal article: Abbreviations of journal titles should be done in accordance with journal abbreviations used in Index Medicus (for journal abbreviations consult List of Journals indexed for MEDLINE published annually by NLM at <http://www.nlm.nih.gov/tsd/serials/fj.html>). In case of six or less authors numbers list of all authors is required. If number of authors exceeds seven, list first 6 authors followed by et al. After list of authors, the full title of the article, journal title, year, volume and pages should follow.

Example: Muller C, Buttnar HJ, Peterson J, Roskomun H. A randomized comparison of clopidogrel and aspirin versus ticlopidine and aspirin after placement of coronary artery stents. Circulation 2000; 101: 590-3.

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
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
